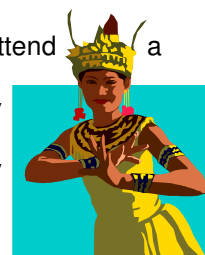

Mobile Phone Muster -

Most people buy a new phone around every 2 years. More than 52% keep their old phones, resulting in over 16 million used phones being stashed away in cupboards and drawers at home and at work.

If your family has old phones not being used at home why not have them brought to school as Bomaderry High is participating in the official recycling program of the mobile phone industry.



You may be interested to know that 90% of materials in mobile phones can be recovered. The plastic components are shredded and made into various products such as pallets and PVC fence posts. The metals from the circuit boards and batteries are extracted and used in the manufacture of jewellery, pots and pans and other items.

Please note that all phones are recycled and not refurbished. Prior to handing in your old phones remember to remove your sim card first so no personal data can be retrieved. All phones can be handed in at the front office.

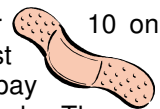
