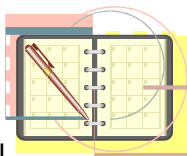

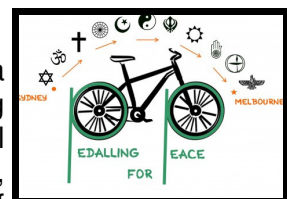

Pedalling for Peace will see a multifaith group of young adults cycle from Sydney all the way down to Melbourne, spreading the message of tolerance and harmony along the way.

One participant representing each religion will take part, creating a small group of 5-6 riders. The challenging journey of 1,050 km will be covered in 9 days, kicking off on Tuesday, 24th November and arriving in Melbourne in time for the Parliament on 3rd December.



There is much more to Pedalling for Peace (P4P) than just the ride. P4P are partnering with both Together for Humanity and Shift International to develop an anti-prejudice and multicultural harmony program which they will run in schools along the way. P4P will also host interfaith events at local community centres and have themed discussions as a group.

The entire journey will be filmed for a major documentary. All Year 9 have been selected to be part of this wonderful presentation to be held in the School Hall, Period 4, on Wednesday, 25th November, commencing at 2.15pm.
